DACA Student Academic Forgiveness Plan

Background:

DACA students attending City, Mesa and Miramar Colleges are being impacted in many ways as a result of the recent notice of elimination of the program. Of particular concern is that some students are not eligible to renew their status and must drop all or some of their fall classes to work more hours to save money for their futures.

Proposal:

Offer DACA students who have withdrawn from classes the option for a late drop and refund of fees, if applicable (academic forgiveness). *after "official drop etc"*

Impact:

- 1) Students will not have W's impacting their academic standing
- 2) Students not receiving financial aid will not incur expense for classes they had to drop.
- 3) District will not receive apportionment

Process:

- 1) Send DACA students an email with an option to petition for a late drop if they dropped their classes due to their DACA status.
- 2) Petition should include an explanation for the late drop related to DACA status and documentation, if available, for audit purposes.
- 3) Petitions will be returned to District Student Services office for processing.
