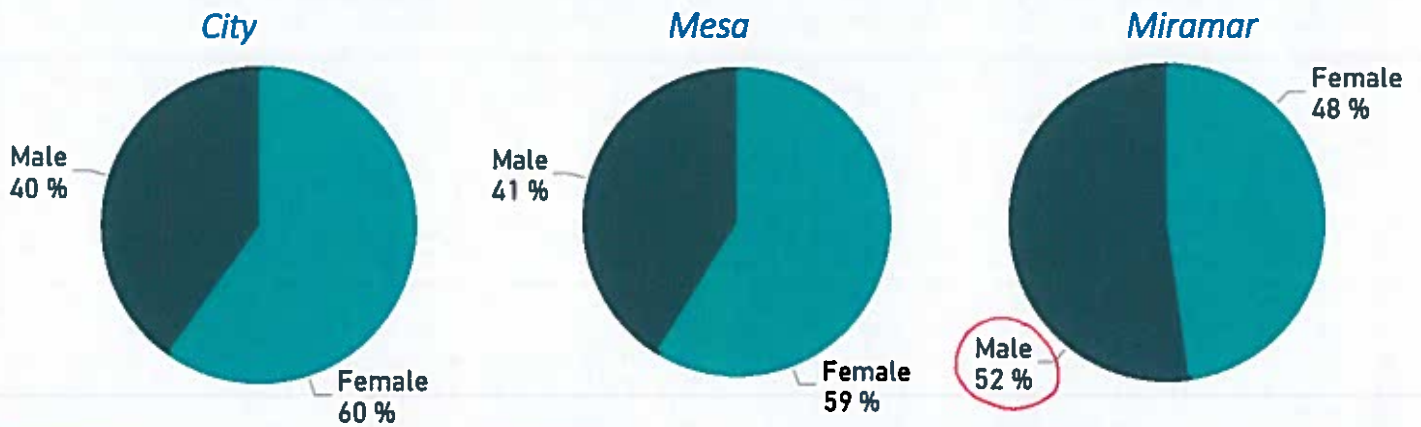

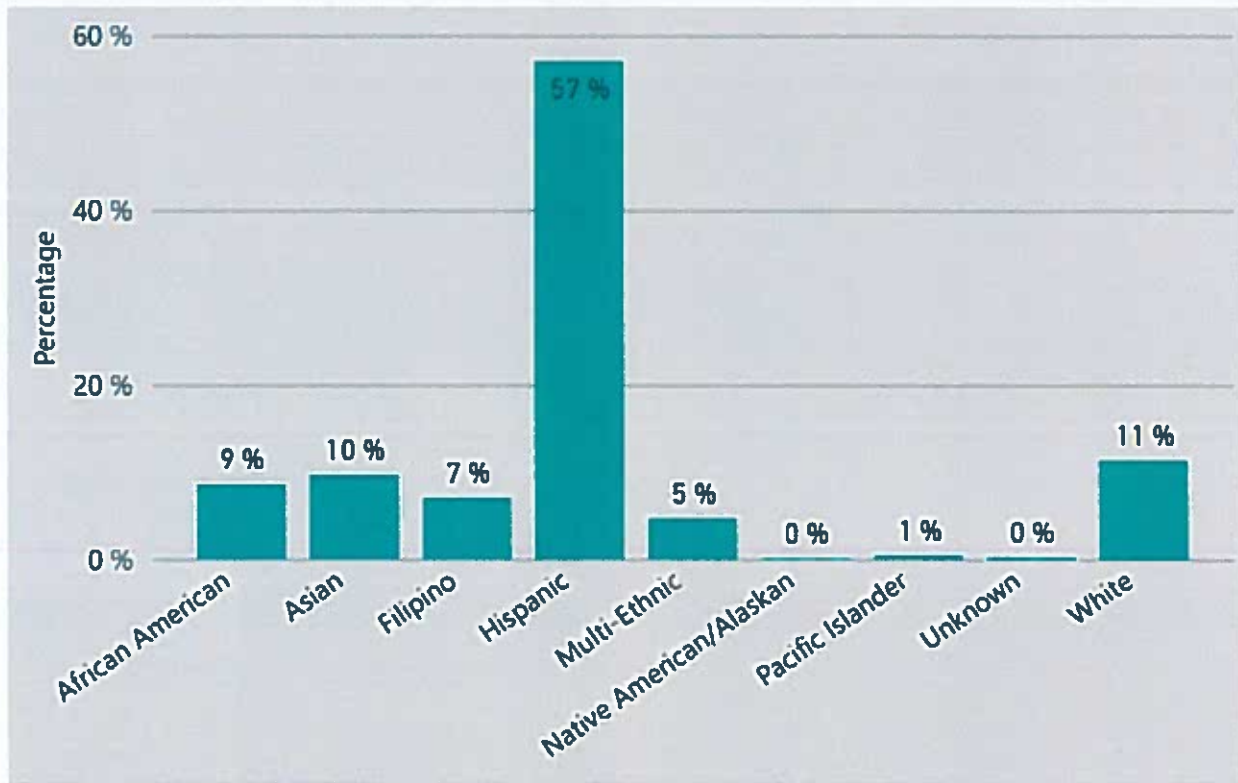

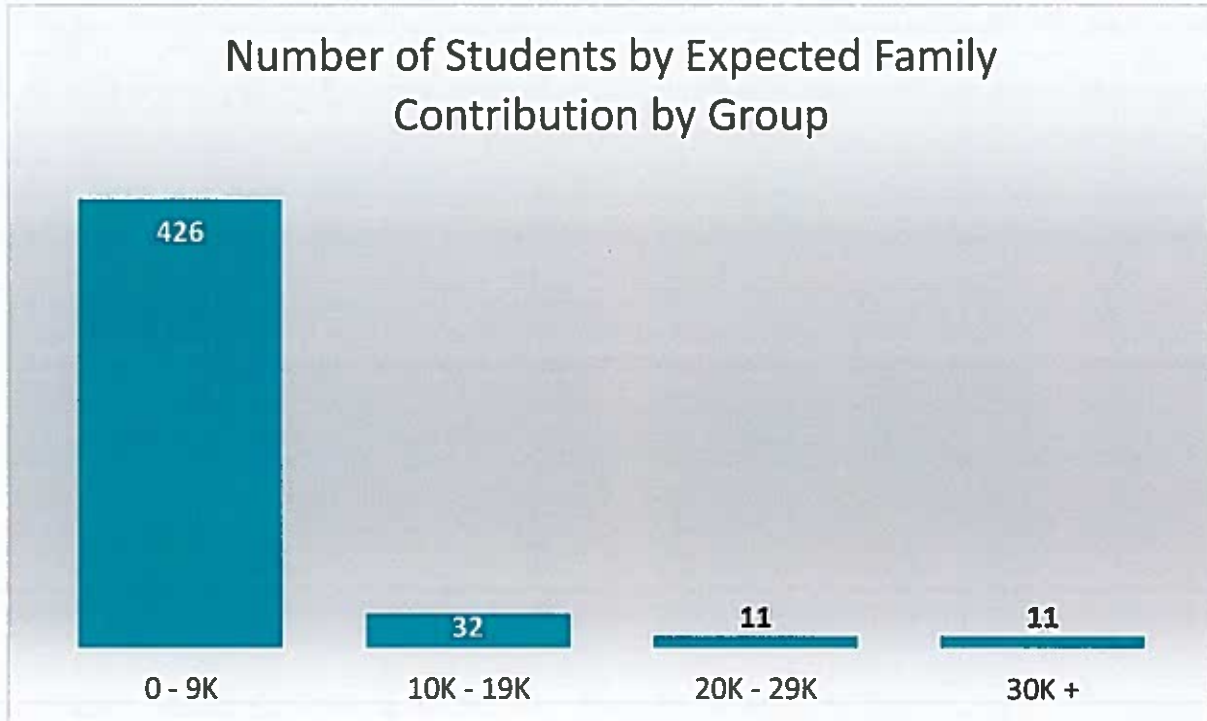
Income and Financial Aid Need

Financial Need Summary

9% students are in families that do not qualify for any financial aid. Of those that did qualify for financial aid, the average income was almost \$30,000 for a family of 4. 32 students were identified as Dreamers.

The average unmet need is \$9,730.67 with a total of about \$4 million remaining of unmet need for the cohort.
