The discussion ensued around the idea that the committee is not fulfilling the larger role of managing professional development for the entire college. There is a specific role for faculty PD in the form of the regulatory Flexible Calendar requirements but this is only one part of the bigger PD picture. It was agreed that the Staff Development Committee's recommendation to narrow its focus would be moved forward. And the CGC would further consider how best to integrate the broader need for strategically managing Professional Development into the governance model.

 Murphy was tasked with investigating impact to other areas of program review and
 assessment to see how those committees felt about the proposed changes. She was
 unable to get to all of them, but what did come up was that both outcomes assessment
 and program review should not managed in silos. Murphy agreed to take the issue back
 to PIEC and have a bigger conversation about consolidating the work into a global PR
 committee and OA committee. This change will need some time to flesh out the practical
 implementation details but what was clear is that processes should not have to be rereplicated for each instance of planning, as has happened to often.
