New Business:

III. Discuss Diversity Committee Collaboration with Title IX Grant Project

J. Patacsil gave an update on this item. SDCCD submitted a Title IX grant which was federally funded, but the funding stays at the district office. The grant was written by Chris May & there is interest in connecting to the Diversity Committees on each of the campuses. The details are still forthcoming, but the emphasis on cultural competency is a focus of the grant in relation to education & prevention of domestic violence & sexual assault.
