A. COVID-19 Roundtable | 15 Minutes

The Assembly shall discuss and take actions on matters pertaining to COVID-19, including but not limited to:

- **Updates from the Stimulus Task Force (Vice President Dehestani and Senate Representative Martinez)**

President Van reported on behalf of Sen Rep Martinez and reported that faculty are requesting a pay raise due to the recent change of events and change in teaching methods.

Sen Rep Martinez argued that many faculty members put into a lot of effort however not the faculty members wholly.

Senator Patel: agrees that not all faculty are spending as much effort as others. However, there should not be an increase in pay

Senator Pearson: know what extra work they need to do and how much raise they need, so we can consider the criteria

Senator Wyatt: faculty facing an issue about full-time or adjunct - full-time faculty receive more benefits than adjuncts, so take this into consideration

Senator Azai: Some classes have already been online, so the raise does not need to be

Senator Azai: Spend money on professional development to help faculty to improve their teaching online classes

Senator Wyatt: ASCCC Webinar about the challenges students are facing through this experience - concerns: some students think that they should not be held to the same academic standard as before. The way they learn has certainly changed dramatically, so the academic rigor might need to be adjusted to be more lenient.

Club Rep. Ashe: Concurr. However, students do not always utilize resources.

Senator Patel: Survey questions for students - which classes are you taking, if you asked for help, did you get the help you needed?

Based on a warning system where the offender would be given two warnings with grace periods of two weeks between each of them, to address the complaint against them. If not compliant, the assembly will take the matter into their own hands. Along with a public hearing.

Senator Azai: The individual with the complaint should remain anonymous.

President Van requests that the SA committee adds on both prospects when going into the ASG council vote.

President Van: what is a way to make sure that the judicial review board remains unbiased? The facts should be brought from parties other than the judge.

Club Rep Jordan Ashe: This is a plan for the worst-case scenario, however, it is a chance for an offender to correct themselves.
