## San Diego Miramar College Applying for a Sabbatical Leave, 2018-2019

## SABBATICAL LEAVES

Sabbatical leave opportunities are detailed in Article 18 of the AFT Guild College Faculty Agreement and Article 9 of the Adult Educators Agreement. (www.aftguild.org)

- 1. The number of sabbaticals for 2018-2019 has not been announced yet. Miramar had 4 slots in 2017-2018.
- 2. Full-time tenured faculty may apply for a sabbatical after six (6) consecutive years of service.
- 3. Sabbaticals can be used for:
  - \*Study
  - \*Retraining
  - \*Teaching, learning and appropriate instructional and student services
  - \*Research
- 4. Important dates for 2018-2019 sabbatical leave applicants:

**Friday, February 2, 2018** – Application due to appropriate Department Chair/Supervisor. *Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure these get to the dean by the deadline.* 

**Friday, February 9, 2018** – completed sabbatical leave request due to school dean or appropriate manager. *Faculty members applying for a research sabbatical must schedule a meeting with the President to discuss their sabbatical and the methodologies being used. This needs to be done prior to the submission of the sabbatical to the PAC.* 

**Friday, February 23, 2018** – Deans/Manager forward sabbatical leave requests to Chair of Professional Advancement Committee (PAC), Roger Olson.

**Friday, March 16, 2018** – PAC forwards their recommendations to Vice President.

**Monday, April 2, 2018** – Vice President forwards recommendations to College President.

**Friday, April 13, 2018** – College President notifies applicants regarding their application. President usually does not notified folks until after sabbaticals are approved at the SDCCD Board meeting.

Note: Faculty are advised to follow up on their applications to make sure the applications are moved along in a timely manner.

Note: If any date listed falls on a weekend or holiday, the new date shall be the first working day following the listed date.
