The Club Certification Packet is in PDF which can be filled out online and submitted by email to smarquez@sdccd.edu or by bringing the completed packet to the Student Affairs office K1-210. Once completed, keep a copy for your club records and email or drop off the original to the Student Affairs Office by Thursday, September 6, 2018, by 4:00 p.m.

However, please note that packets may be submitted during the summer. Minutes must be provided verifying the results of club elections and the slate of new officers. You will receive formal notification once the certification process has been completed and approved and that your club has been certified for the Fall 2017 semester. You will be required to ensure club representation at the Club Orientation. Please note, all new Advisors and all club officers are required to attend the orientation. However, continuing advisors are welcome to attend should you desire. This session is designed to ensure a smooth process during the year.
