English Assessment Tests:

Test Exemptions:

In order for test exemptions to be considered, students must submit official test scores to the District Student Services for review. Unofficial copies cannot be accepted. For students with EAP / CAASPP exemptions, please call 619.388.6937. AP Test scores must be officially submitted via transcripts and official qualifying scores through the College Board of three or higher. Alternative measures of standardized tests must have been completed within the past two years.
