## K2 Student Resource & Welcome Center

- Outreach Department provides campus tours, peer student support, as well as student services information.
- Health Services provides medical care to students such as basic urgent care and preventative care.
- Mental Health Counseling provides emotional care such as stress management and crisis intervention.
- Assessment provides students with the tool to be placed into English and Mathematics courses based on self-reported data or by taking the ELAC-English Language Acquisition exam.

## F-1 Aviation Building

- Get extensive classroom instruction, work experience, and top notch training in aviation. Earn a certificate of achievement toward your FAA Airframe and Powerplant (A&P) certificate or an associate's degree in airframe technology, Powerplant or both.
- The Aviation Maintenance Technology School is the only Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved and officially designated FAA school in San Diego and Imperial Counties.

## F-2 Child Development Center

- Child Development program offers classes and training to meet the states licensing requirements in order to work in preschools, child care homes, and other service related agencies.
- Student enrolled in lab classes can sign up their children for the center, there is a cost and it is based on student income.

## J Buildings- Fitness Center/ Aquatic Center

- Nutrition and physical activity classes such as dance/aerobics, access to tennis courts, and basketball courts.
- Miramar College sports include Men & Women's Water Polo, Women's Soccer, Men's Basketball, and Men's Volleyball
- To use the gym, you must enroll in the gym class. It can be taken as 1 unit or half a unit, depending on the hours you want to put in. Access to the public is available with a cost.

## I - English Building

- English classes are located here, including lecture halls and English professors' offices.

## H - Arts & Humanities Building

- Houses classes such as psychology, behavioral science, art history, history, language, and communication.
- The Ceramics lab includes spinning wheels, glazes and oven for completed works for pottery, sculpture and other artistic projects. The room is also used for 3-D design.
- The Art Studio Lab includes drawing tables, easels, freehand drawing, and painting classes.

## L - Library Learning Resource Center

- Provides computers, copiers/printers (pay for print), interlibrary loans, reference assistance, group study rooms, reserves, WiFi, and quiet study areas.
- The ASC (Academic Success Center) is dedicated to helping students succeed in their classes by providing quality academic support services such as online tutoring, open writing labs, open math labs, on-going study groups, and computers with internet access and Wi-Fi.
- The ILC (Independent Learning Center) is an open student computer lab for students enrolled in a credit course at any of the three campuses (City, Mesa or Miramar). English Center can be found in the ILC which provide writing support.

## Compass Point

- Center of Miramar College. The outer rim: The grassy area is actually a giant compass with degree markings. Inside the compass: It lights up at night in the shape of an hourglass which is a replica of the hourglass shaped runway that used to be on the military base to help be easily identifiable from the air.

## M Business & Math Building

- Classrooms include computers built into the desks and hook-ups for laptops at each working station & lecture classrooms with smart technology.
- The Mathematics Lab offers a computer-assisted lab and tutoring area for math.

## R Buildings- Fire Technology & EMT

- The Fire and EMT training center benefits 50 departments countywide.
- Fire Technology: The two-year program trains individuals to perform rescues and protect lives and property from fire. Fire Technology used to be one of the original programs provided back when Miramar College was a public training facility in 1969.
- EMT: Designed to offer comprehensive education and skills-training in the provision of prehospital emergency care. The course completion certificate is a requirement of eligibility to complete the NREMT Cognitive Examination for EMTs (certifying exam for EMTs in the State of California). San Diego Miramar College EMT Program is accredited through San Diego County Emergency Medical Services Agency.

## S-5 & S-6 Science Buildings
