What is Accessibility?

In the terms of instruction accessibility refers to the practice of making your content usable to any and all students.

What does an Accessible Online Course look like?

An accessible course will look like any other online course except with a few key differences. Usually these classes will aim to use online

technologies and resources compatible with the programs, and software students with disabilities use for their online environments.



How do I Make my Course Accessible?
