



Hypothesis Test

Are the average hours per student for the semester for each room significantly different from each other? L101 will be represented by the subscript L and M211A by the subscript M

$$H_0: \mu_L = \mu_M$$

$$H_A: \mu_L \neq \mu_M$$

I calculated standard deviation from the weekly hours per student for each room, yielding .214988 hrs/student for L101 and .259211 hrs/student for M211A. The combined standard deviation was .08695 and the test statistic was .3115, yielding a p-value of .757, enough to conclude that there is no significant difference between M211A and L101 in terms of hours/student for the semester.
