

Free Meals For Children (18 And Younger)

Any child 18 or younger can go to any school site providing meals and receive food during this period of school closures due to COVID-19.

Below are the food service sites confirmed for San Diego Unified School District and Poway Unified School District where students will be provided meals during the school closures.

Children will need to be present to receive meals, and each child 18 years and younger can take one lunch and one breakfast for the next day. All food must be consumed off site.
