Subject: Club Certification

Please be aware that per District Policy, all clubs and organizations, regardless of them being associated with ASG, must go through the certification process on a yearly basis as well as attend the Club Orientation. Last year, the Office of Student Affairs worked with ASG to delineate two different categories of clubs:

Associated Student Chartered Club:

- Bound by the SDCCD Club operating guidelines (AP 3200 Associated Students Organizations and Guidelines for Students Clubs and Organizations)
- Required to designate an ASG representative who will attend the weekly ASG Meetings.
- Can receive club funding (Vending 5000) at the end of the Semester which can be used for club activities and events.

Certified Club:

- Bound by the SDDCD operating guidelines (AP 3200 Associated Students Organizations and Guidelines for Students Clubs and Organizations)
- Not required to designate an ASG representative
- Not eligible to receive ASG funding.

Please be aware that the Club Certification packet for the 2020/2021 academic year is located on the Miramar Web page under Campus Resources/Student Affairs Office/Important Documents. As per District Manual 3200, all clubs must register annually.

To register simply download and fill out The Club Certification Packet then submit by email to smarquez@sdccd.edu before the deadline date of **Thursday, September 3, 2020, by 4:00 p.m**. Listed below is the link to the club certification packet for your convenience.

However, please note that packets may be submitted during the summer. Minutes must be provided verifying the results of club elections and the slate of new officers. You will receive formal notification once your club has been certified for the 2020/2021 academic year. You will be required to ensure representation at the Club Orientation. Please note, all new Advisors and all club officers are required to attend the orientation. However, continuing advisors are welcome to attend should you desire.
