*Students may clear prerequisites if they have AP Credit or College level credit for English or Math; an SAT English score of 500 or above, SAT Math score of 560 or above; ACT English score of 22 or higher, ACT Math score of 23; EAP College Level designation; EPT English score of 151 or above; ELM Math score of 50. - Bring your picture ID and your College Student ID Number to the testing room indicated on the front on the Assessment Schedule. Walk-in tests are not timed, you should allow at least 1 hour for either English or Math tests, 2 hours for both tests. No calculators, dictionaries or, electronic translators are allowed.
- An online virtual orientation of Miramar College and completion of a short quiz is suggested prior to taking your assessment test(s) at: http://www.sdmiramar.edu/stu_svcs/counseling/orientation.asp
- Upon completion of your test(s) you will be given a copy of your placement scores. **(You may only take the test once every three years at City, Mesa or Miramar.)**
- Your scores will be posted within 2 business days and you will be able to register online through Reg-E at: <https://studentweb.sdccd.edu/reg-e> You may also "View Placement Levels" on Reg-E.
- Your first semester course plans can be made with a counselor in C-302 on a walk-in basis. (Remember to bring your assessment results with you!) To clear prerequisites you may send official college transcripts, EAP college credit, SAT, ACT, EAP, EPT or ELM scores to: The San Diego Community College District Student Services Prerequisite Evaluators. *Counseling Office C-302 (619) 388-7840*
